**Derby Rules**

1. There are three divisions: 5 &6-year-olds (A) ; 7 &8-year-olds (B); and 9, 10, 11- & 12-years old (C). (The Ikes' reserve the right to adjust the age groupings for balance)
2. Children should have their own fishing pole.
3. Official bait will be provided, courtesy of Jigger Wholesale Bait and Tackle.
4. Parents/guardians may help bait the hooks and clear rods, lines and reels in all age groups. Parents may **assist** children in the younger age group with casting.
5. Prizes will be awarded by age group for the largest fish caught, the most fish caught and fishing dedication/enthusiasm as determined by the judges. A prize will be awarded for first fish caught. Rulings of the judges are final.
5. A grand-prize drawing of an outdoor adventure package will be held for each age group. Participants must be present for the drawing.
7. Names, information on and photographs of participants and their parents/guardians may be publicized by the Oil City Chapter, IWLA.

# Special 2020 Rules

These special rules and requests are in response to the current Covid-19 pandemic and the need to comply with state requirements and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations. The changes and rules were adopted after lengthy discussion with the emphasis on how this event could continue this year rather than be cancelled.

1. Everyone is required to wear a face mask while registering and at any time they are not at least six feet away from anyone other than family members. This requirement is in place from the moment of exiting vehicles until returning. People should bring their own masks.
2. Participants and their parent/guardians will be assigned a marked and numbered area around the pond, which are large enough to allow for “social distancing” and the removal of masks while within the marked area. Family groups should remain within their assigned areas.
3. The areas will be assigned by random drawing upon submitting the registration form.
