Weather Siren Information

- Weather siren information is posted around the park. Please familiarize yourself with the meaning of the siren.
- Siren Signals:
 - o *Tornado Warning*: Steady tone for 90 seconds, followed by approximate 2-minute pause, and then another 90 second alert siren.
 - Flood Warning: Up and down traditional tone that will last for 90 seconds, followed by an approximate 2-minute pause, and then another 90 second wail siren.
 - o *All Clear:* A slow rising siren tone lasting approximately 15 seconds.

Severe Weather Information

- In the event of severe weather (i.e., severe thunderstorm, tornado) an announcement should be made on the PA for people to take shelter immediately.
- In the case of a severe thunderstorm, under the bridge is NOT protection. Seek shelter in your vehicle. If you cannot safely make it to your vehicle, emergency personnel will direct you to a safe location which include (depending on the event location): The Days Inn, The Salvation Army, The CATA Bus Garage, The Oil City Library, and the Grace United Methodist Church. These shelters are for SEVERE weather only, not just because of rain.

Emergency Services

• The Oil City Fire Department and Community Ambulance will have personnel on standby in the park during Friday and Saturday's activities.

Evacuation

• Should the park need evacuated for any reason, *please remain calm* and exit in an orderly fashion. Pushing, shoving, and running only add to confusion and injuries.
