- Line-up numbers will be sent via the email address provided on the registration form and will be mailed the week of the parade, to the address on the form.
- Please register for the parade by **July 1st** - late entries are accommodated wherever possible.

****The theme of this year's Festival/Parade will be: "Celebrating Our Trails!"***

You are encouraged to incorporate this theme into your unit.*

Judging

- Floats/Walking Groups and Novelty Groups will be judged as you proceed through the judging area at Central Avenue Plaza, Southside. They will be judged on General Effect, Design, and Construction. Each float will be judged within its division.
- Performance Groups will be judged at their performance in front of the judging area at Central Avenue Plaza. They will be judged on Choreography, General Effect, and Showmanship.
- Marching Units/Fire & Rescue Equipment/Cars/Motorized Units, etc. **will not be judged.**

To prevent lulls in the parade, please stay as close as possible to the group in front of you.

Awards

Parade winners will be announced on Facebook, and prizes will be available at the Venango Chamber one week following the parade.

Line-Up

We will attempt to accommodate special requests for line-up as much as possible. Early responses are typically given preferential position so please reply as quickly as you can if your entry has a specific need and must be noted clearly on the registration form.

Weather

The parade **will not** be cancelled! In the case of extreme weather (heat or storms), please heed advice and take cover. Unless there is a threat of danger, the parade will continue. We encourage you to do what is best for your group to be safe and comfortable. In the event of a true emergency, we will attempt to notify the public through all available media.

Categories:

Performing Group: Check one/Performing entries will be judged and awarded monetary prizes in each category.

- Senior Drill/Drum & Baton Team
- Junior Drill/Drum & Baton Team
- Gymnastics
- Dance Performance Group

Drum and Baton Corps: Have baton twirlers as the mainstay of their unit. Baton corps usually consist of baton twirlers, silks, and a drum line (or a good quality sound system).

Drill Team: Have a dance line as the mainstay of their unit. The dance line may use pom-poms, flags, rifles, etc. Drill teams will usually have music to accompany them.

Junior Corps: Have an average age of thirteen or younger. **Senior Corps:** Have an average age of fourteen or older.

Novelty Groups: Check one/Novelty entries will be judged and awarded gift cards in each category.

- Musical Performance Groups
- Non-Musical Performance Groups - (Zumba, sports teams, clowns, horse groups, etc.)

Horse groups must have a clean-up crew to follow their unit through the parade.

Floats/Walking Groups: Check one/Floats/Walking group entries will be judged and awarded gift cards.

- Commercial: Business float or walking group
- Non-Profits: Churches, Youth Service float, walking group

Walking Groups: To prevent lulls in the parade, it is very important for your group to stay as close as possible to the group in front of you. Our parade is a forward-motion parade, and we ask for your assistance in maintaining a close distance between each group.

Other: the following entries will not be judged

- Marching Units - high school university, cheerleaders, drum & bugle, color guard
- Fire Equipment -please provide description
- Cars/Motorized Units - elected officials, dignitaries, kings/queens, princes/princesses, award winners

- Your units bio must be submitted with application. This information will be provided to the parade emcee and local radio and television stations. If this is not provided, nothing will be announced for your unit.
- For safety reasons, no simulated or actual firearms or weapons will be allowed in the parade, with the exception of March Unit Color Guards and Military Service Groups/Organizations.
- Throwing items/candy from a float/vehicle is highly discouraged. It is preferred that walkers are in place to distribute items/candy. At the risk of the Parade participant, candy may be dispersed by throwing underhand onto the surface of the street toward the curb. Any dispersal of candy other than by walkers is the sole responsibility and at the risk of the Parade participant.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Can we be in the front/back/certain position in the lineup?

Please submit special requests on the registration form. We will try to honor requests but reserve the right to make all final lineup decisions. Please submit your form in a timely manner to have your special requests considered. There is a parade etiquette that is followed every year, so the first 10+ spots are usually reserved.

2. Can we be lined up next to _____?

See above.

3. How long is the parade?

The parade is about a mile long.

4. Can we throw candy?

You may hand out candy. We ask that you do so respectfully and safely, and keep candy on the edges of the road so children are not drawn into the parade route.

5. What if it rains? Will the parade be rescheduled?

We will hold the parade rain or shine. In the case of extreme weather (heat or storms), please heed advice and take cover. Unless there is a threat of danger, the parade will continue. We encourage you to do what is best for your group to be safe and comfortable. The parade will not be rescheduled under any circumstance.

6. What is the parade route?

Lineup for the parade begins at the intersection of West First and Orange Streets and will extend down West First Street until all groups are lined up. The parade will follow West First Street to State Street, cross the Veterans Bridge and then proceed down Seneca Street, ending at the intersection of Seneca and Duncomb Streets.

7. When do I get my lineup information?

Lineup information will be sent via email to the email address provided on the registration form. Lineup information will also be mailed the week of the parade, to the address on the form. Your lineup number will correspond with a number placed along West First Street.

8. Is there a fee?

There is no fee for our parade.
